I also came across this bug yesterday.

It seems that the issue is caused due to the early call of  
configure\_logging inside webproject/manage.py. The function imports  
synnefo.settings module to access SNF\_MANAGE\_LOGGING\_SETUP variable.  
This happens right before command options get resolved, causing  
settings module to be improperly initialized.
